We do our best to accommodate food allergies if notified two weeks ahead of scheduled camp with this form signed. We do not prepare special food due to preference.

We serve buffet style meals and we serve salad bar every lunch and dinner and fruit at every breakfast. Please be aware that we are not a dedicated facility and process all types of food in the same kitchen.

For those parents extremely concerned: Due to cooking for high volume, it will be very helpful for your student to pack some of his/her substitution food. We can discuss the need for this if needed, depending on your child’s particular allergy and how severe. Yes, there is refrigeration and storage.

Note: Our Tin Spur, the snack shop, does have candy bars and chips that possibly contain nuts or have been made in factories with nuts. We also serve milkshakes.
